

GOOD SPIRIT BIBLE CAMP



Position: Junior Cabin Leader

Goal:

To continue to strengthen camp ministry skills by one on one mentorship with a Senior Cabin Leader, by helping lead activities and cabin devotions and by hanging out with campers and telling them about Jesus.

Requirements:

1. Be at least 15 years of age
2. Have a relationship with Jesus Christ and show signs of Christian growth.
3. Be involved in a church.
4. Complete and turn in the Jr. Cabin leader application including reference letters and criminal record check.

Responsibilities:

1. Be on time for the pre-camp staff meeting, as well as welcome and escort campers to their cabins the first day of camp.
2. Attend the staff training week and participate in staff missions and service projects.
3. Attend weekly Jr. training sessions and devotions, as well as morning staff meetings.
4. Live a life that reflects Christian morals and values in front of the campers at camp and away from camp.
5. Assist in nightly cabin devotions.
6. Assist in leading skill activities.
7. Use your free time for meditation, prayer and reading your Bible.
8. Be prepared to sacrifice some of your "rights" for the benefit of the campers and the camp.
9. Assist the speaker during chapel and campfire.
10. Be prepared to share the story of Jesus with campers.
11. Hang out with campers and build relationships with them.
12. Help the Sr. Cabin leaders accomplish their tasks and look for opportunities to learn from them.
13. Remain teachable and moldable so that signs of improvement are seen at summer's end.
14. Clean up the camp at week's end and attend the debrief meeting to fill out evaluations regarding the week's events.

Working Relationships:

1. Answer to the Sr. Cabin Leader you are assigned to.
2. Assist the Program Director and Camp Director if needed.
3. Be prepared to help out in other areas of the camp.
